From our origins in improving local lives and livelihoods two centuries ago, we're now on a mission to become a force for good locally, nationally and globally.

We're much more than a university; we're a thriving community of more than 5,100 committed and talented colleagues using our world-class facilities, diverse backgrounds and experiences to innovate and transform lives.

Excellent Education

As one of the top ten most applied to UK universities for undergraduates (UCAS 2023), we're the students' choice.

We transform our students' lives through excellent education and a well-rounded university experience, supporting them to develop the skills and confidence for rewarding careers. We do this through our dynamic course content and delivery, world-class facilities, careers support and quality pastoral care – all in the heart of a vibrant, well-connected city.

Our National Student Survey feedback (2024) was our best yet, ranking us in the top 15 out of all UK universities. And the quality of our teaching has secured us Gold status in the Teaching Excellence Framework (TEF 2023).

Excellent research with impact

Working with communities, business and industry, our research agenda truly tackles the grand challenges of our time. It's why we saw our best-ever performance in the Research Excellence Framework (REF 2021), with 90% of our research rated as 'world-leading' or 'internationally excellent.' Four subjects are in the top ten for 'research power'.

And we've achieved a new 'best' in research grants and awards – receiving over £29m in 2024, so we can keep making a difference. Highlights include £3.8m from AHRC for our Robotics Living Lab, £1m from MRC for research on Parkinson's and £1m from EPSRC for facial prosthetics.

The power behind our progress

Being Manchester Met takes some work. We have more than 43,000 students from over 100 countries, a gold-rated teaching community, 90% of our research is rated 'world-leading' or internationally excellent and we rank as one of the top 10 most applied to UK universities for undergraduates.

The University's Professional Services are key to ensuring we remain one of the UK's most popular and forward-thinking universities, from strategically planning for our future to delivering and maintaining our world-class facilities.

Professional Services encompasses many student and academic services and all the day-to-day operations that keep the University running smoothly. It also includes teams focused on maximising the impact of our outstanding research and excellent education.

Our Professional Services teams are located where they can be most effective and efficient. For instance, Marketing and People and Organisational Development serve all directorates and faculties centrally, while research support teams are embedded within faculties for a greater understanding of their specialist area. Expert business partners work alongside faculty leadership, providing strategic advice to support the delivery of the faculty and University's priorities.

Professional Services having access to specialist knowledge, a clear focus on aims and priorities and agile teams means Manchester Met has been able to transform its campus and deliver exciting new initiatives such as the School of Digital Arts and brand-new green spaces, including All Saints Park. The Dalton building, home to the Faculty of Science and Engineering, is our most ambitious project to date. It's set to become a global hub for innovation, research and industry collaboration.

Academic Services

We're one of the leading university providers for degree apprenticeships and this Unit keeps us up there, overseeing the University's strategy and delivering and developing our programmes.

We develop relationships with partners regionally, nationally and internationally, creating placements, job and volunteering opportunities for our students with the likes of Manchester United, Team GB, Northern Care Alliance, The Insights Family and Vivobarefoot. 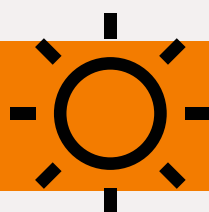

In May 2015, the charter was expanded to recognise work undertaken in arts, humanities, social sciences and business and law, and in professional and support roles, and for transgender staff and students.

The charter now recognises work undertaken to address gender equality more broadly, and not just barriers to progression that affect women and makes explicit acknowledgement of intersectionality in its remit.



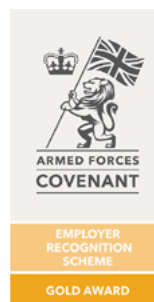
Race Equality Charter Bronze Award
